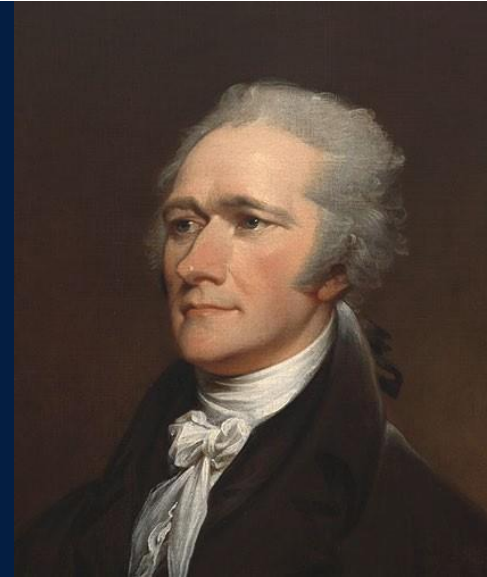

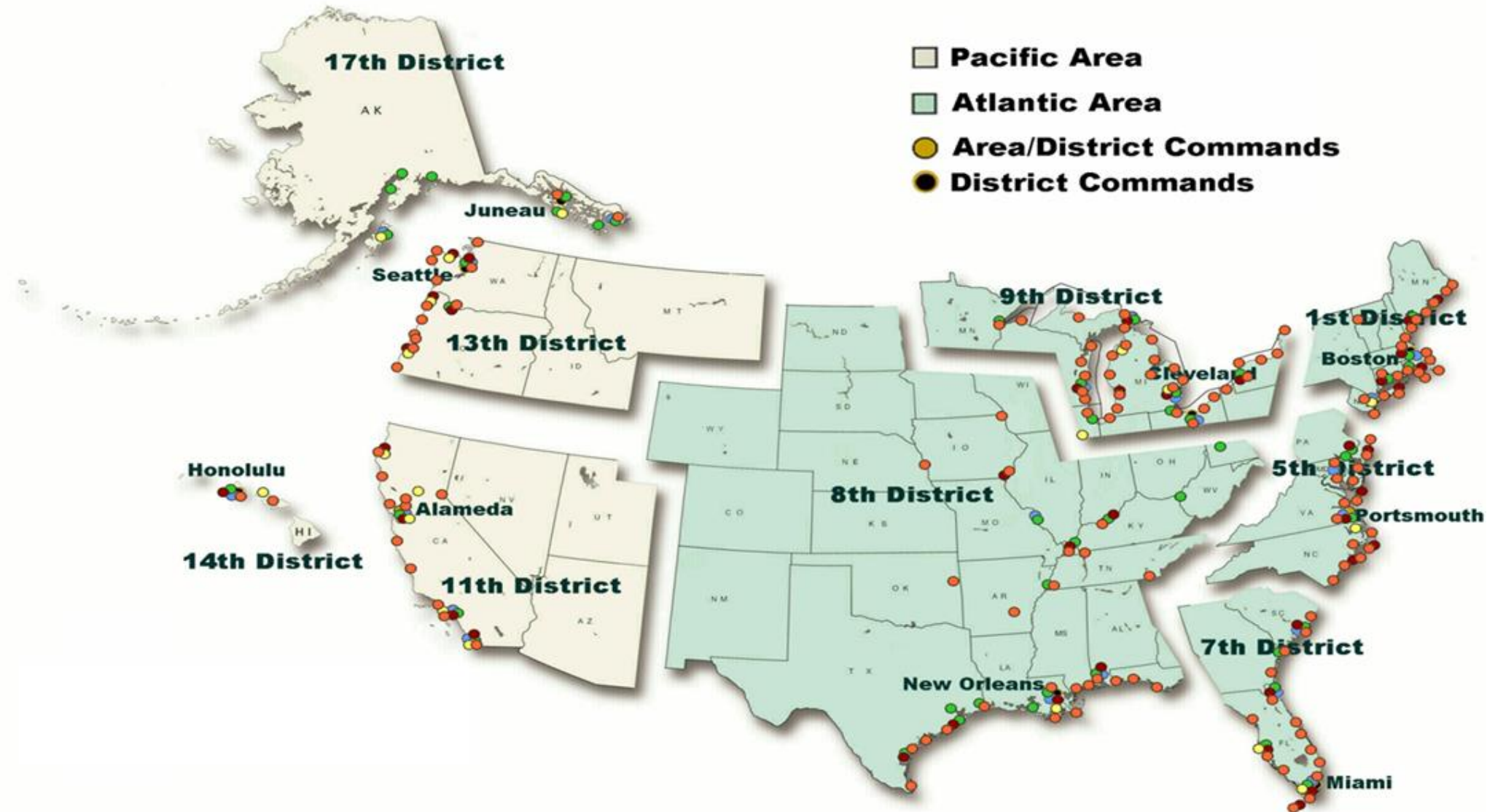

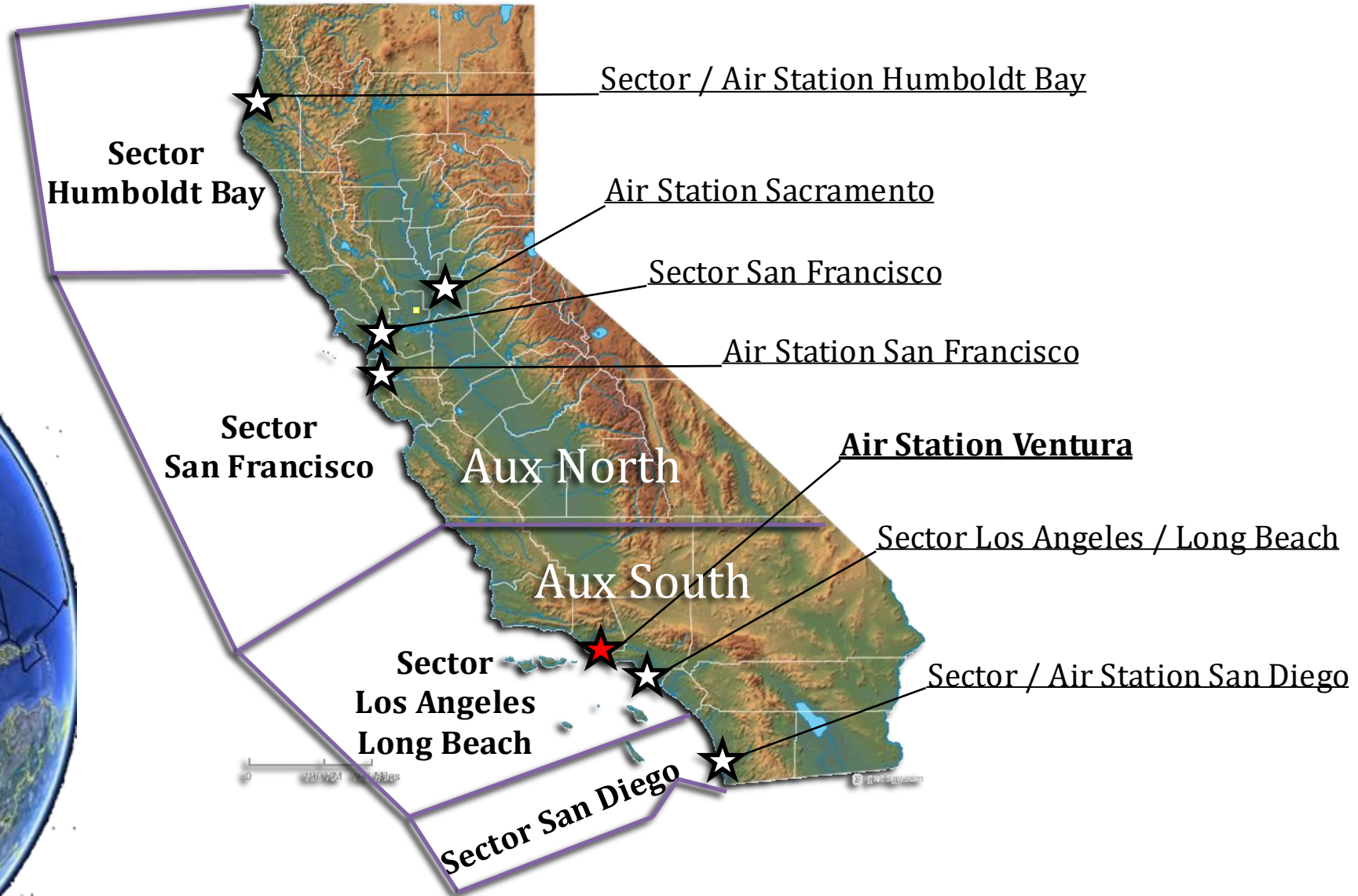

D11 Air Assets



HC-27J: (4) Air Station Sacramento

- Not missionized w/ integrated sensor package which limits effectiveness for covert MPA use.
- FY23-24 over eight months of lost availability due to multiple fleet-wide groundings
- FY27-28 Sunset



MH-60T: (1) Air Station Ventura (2) Sector San Diego

- Supports MSRT San Diego's Basic Fast Roping Capability
- Provides personnel and assets to support Advanced Helicopter Rescue Swimmer School and Arctic SAR Support for PACAREA



MH-65E: (3) Sector Humboldt Bay (4) Air Station San Francisco

- *Units combine to support 291 DDAS and 100 DAHS for PACAREA shipboard deployments, Deployable Rotary Wing Air Intercept Support to NORAD Continental Region, and Advanced Helicopter Rescue Swimmer School.*

D11 Surface Assets



USCGC ALDER (225-ft): Homeported in San Francisco with a crew of 42 enlisted and 7 officers. Maintains 76 aids to navigation and deploys in support of D11 operations in the North and Eastern Pacific.

USCGC GEORGE COBB (175-ft): Homeported in San Pedro, CA with a crew of 22 enlisted and 2 officers. Maintains 178 floating aids.



Fast Response Cutters (154-ft): Four homeported in San Pedro and a fifth yet to be delivered, these cutters primarily conduct security and law enforcement in the North and Eastern Pacific.

Patrol Boats (87-ft): These versatile cutters provide a critical role in sustaining D11 capacity to conduct offshore search and rescue, maritime law enforcement, coastal security, and living marine resources protection missions.



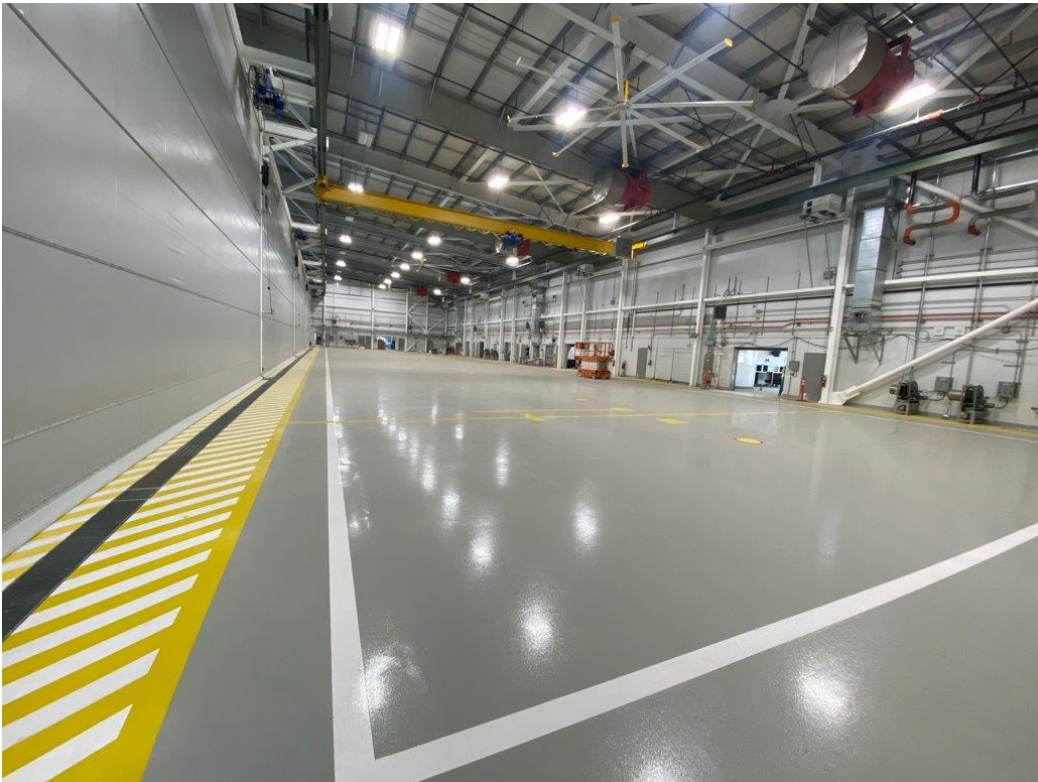
